INITIAL DECISION

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On January 6, 2009, Employee, a parking officer, DS-1802-6/3, filed a petition for appeal with this Office, challenging Agency's final decision to terminate her, effective December 12, 2008, for an on-duty or employment related act or omission that interferes with the efficiency and integrity of government operations and affecting adversely the confidence of the public in the integrity of the government. This matter was assigned to me on June 15, 2009. I held a Prehearing Conference on November 9, 2009, and scheduled a hearing for February 1, 2010. On February 1, 2010, both sides indicated that they had settled the matter.
