**INITIAL DECISION**

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On March 4, 2009, Employee filed a petition for appeal with this Office, challenging Agency's final decision to suspend her from her position as a Management Liaison Specialist, CS-13/4, due to alleged "Any on-duty or Employment-related act or omission that interferes with the efficiency and integrity of government operations." This matter was assigned to me on October 14, 2009. I scheduled a Prehearing Conference for November 6, 2009. Since the parties expressed an interest in mediation, I referred this matter to mediation. On March 26, 2010, I received a note indicating that the parties have settled.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to D.C. Official Code Ann. § 1-606.03(a) (2001).

ISSUE

Whether this matter should be dismissed.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

Since the parties have settled the matter, Employee's petition for appeal is dismissed.
