INITIAL DECISION

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS OF FACT

On May 5, 2010, Employee filed a petition for appeal with this Office pursuant to D.C. Code Ann. § 1-606.3(a) (1999). The Employee appealed Agency's termination of her employment.

This matter was assigned to the undersigned judge on July 10, 2012. I held a prehearing conference on August 13, 2012. I urged the parties to consider settlement. On August 21, 2012, Employee submitted a notice withdrawing her appeal pursuant to a settlement. I closed the record.

JURISDICTION

ISSUE

Whether this appeal should be dismissed.
